St. Michael's Parish has once again brought a Refugee Family to Canada. They arrived on Wednesday November 30, 2011.

This time it is a Catholic Iraqi Family composed of 4 adults:

Mother

Father

Son - 27 years old

Daughter - 21 years old

They came from Syria, where there is a great deal of civil unrest. This family has immediate family here in London who will support them in non-financial ways.

Citizenship and Immigration Canada, through the Asmaro Chaldean Society, are supplying financial aid for the first three months; St. Peter's Seminary and the Sisters of St. Joseph are providing some of the financial support as well, and we are hoping for other contributions.....We will provide one fund-raising event in the beginning of March 2012.
